SEND PROVISION

Our SEND provision specialises in supporting students with a range of learning and behavioural needs, particularly those with social, emotional, and mental health (SEMH) difficulties, and those who are at risk of exclusion or are disengaged from learning.

We aim to offer a calm and nurturing environment where students with an EHCP can thrive. They also integrate vocational pathways into their SEND curriculum, such as ASDAN. Our Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCO) oversees this provision, coordinating support plans, and liaising with parents, outside agencies, and educational psychologists to ensure that each student receives the necessary academic and emotional support.



OMG Education's approach to SEND is centred on the principle of inclusive learning. The school's policies promote equality and diversity and ensure that all students, regardless of their background or learning needs, feel valued and respected. OMG Education provide students with a dedicated mentor to support their individual learning plans and work with external organisations and families to create a comprehensive support system. Ofsted reports have also noted that our staff are well-trained and understand the needs of their SEND pupils, diligently working with parents and external agencies to provide effective, bespoke support.

BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

OMG Education Independent School takes a holistic and therapeutic approach to managing student behaviour, which we believe is motivated by five basic human needs: survival, love and belonging, power, freedom, and fun. Rather than focusing on punishment, We use a strategy called "Choice Theory" to help students understand the triggers for their actions and explore how their choices impact their feelings and well-being.



This model, which examines the Antecedence (trigger), Behaviour, and Consequences of an incident, aims to give students ownership of their actions and encourage them to move out of their comfort zone without instilling fear. In addition to this, OMG provides an individual mentor for each student—who creates a Personal Development Plan to help them develop positive social skills and overcome barriers to learning. We maintain regular contact with parents and works with outside agencies for serious or persistent behavioural issues. This approach is part of our broader mission to offer a supportive, nurturing environment for students who may have experienced difficulties in previous educational settings.



SIXTH FORM PROVISION

At OMG Education's Sixth Form, we specialise in offering adaptive and personalised pathways for students with special educational needs. Our goal is to prepare them for the real world by providing tailored qualifications, an adaptive curriculum, and a supportive environment that fosters a strong sense of belonging and academic achievement.



UNIFORM

We provide a bursary for its students to cover the cost of their school uniform, ensuring that all students can access a complete uniform regardless of their financial background. This policy is a key part of their strategy to promote inclusivity by reducing peer pressure related to clothing. By providing a uniform for free, the school ensures that no student feels excluded or disadvantaged, fostering a sense of belonging and unity among the entire student body.

LOCATION

Located in Aldgate, Central London, a spot chosen for its neutral location that is free from borough and territorial rivalries. This central position and excellent transport links make it easily accessible to students from all over London. The school, which they call the "OMG Safe Haven," aims to provide a secure and supportive environment where young people can escape street pressures and feel safe from gang affiliations or postcode tensions.



TRANSPORT

We arrange a bursary to help students with their travel expenses to ensure they can get to school. This bursary is part of the school's financial aid program and covers the costs of public transport. By offering this support, OMG Education aims to remove financial barriers that might prevent students from attending school regularly, thus promoting attendance and ensuring an inclusive environment where all students have an equal opportunity to thrive.



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
